Instructions for the use and maintenance of screen system ZENITH 2

The ZENITH 2 screen system is a new generation of office screens. It is particularly well suited to the demands of open plan offices. The available options with respect to material combinations and configurations make this system among the most versatile on the market. When designing the system, emphasis was placed on simplicity and function, as well as a wide range of potential uses. When using the system it is necessary to observe the following user instructions.

Description

Various different materials are used in the construction of this screen system. The structural element is a metal frame with grooves into which can be fitted connectors for joining the screens in configurations (in a straight line, at right angles, or at angles $\pm 90^\circ$). The groove in the top profile can be used for the attachment of NOVUM office accessories. The screens themselves come in a variety of material and finish options. The basic screen panel is made from laminated chipboard with a high-quality fabric finish. Fabrics are available in a choice of colours. Further options include lacquered MDF, Plexiglas or pinnable material. It is also possible to integrate toolbars in the screen with one or three grooves for attaching universal accessories from international producers. The design of this screen system ensures high stability and it can be fixed in any position using top and bottom holders. For the free-standing version two types of supporting legs are available. All metal parts have a high quality epoxy-polyester powder paint finish.

Principles for use

- the screens should be placed in a suitable environment (standard climate for office environment, humidity, dust content etc.), and they should not be handles roughly,
- the metal frame and core without fabric cover should be cleaned with non-abrasive cleaning agents (we recommend standard detergents diluted with water). Organic and non-organic solvents should not be used;
- the painted frame and core can be treated with standard furniture polishes and waxes but these must not contain abrasive agents;
- glass can be cleaned with common non-abrasive detergents intended for cleaning glass;
- organic glass surfaces can be cleaned with standard non-abrasive detergents diluted with water. Do not use and organic or inorganic solvents (white spirits, methylated spirits etc.);
- fabric is cleaned with a vacuum cleaner or brush;
- only one shelf or set of filing trays can be attached to each side of the screen;
- nothing should be suspended on a free-standing screen;
- nothing should be fixed to a screen (stuck, pinned to the screen or inserted into the frame);
- the screens should be kept out of excessive heat;
- only trained personnel should assemble or dismantle the screens.
